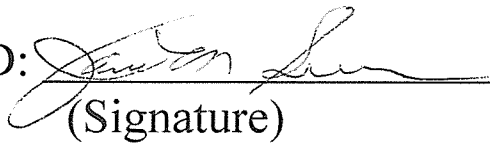

SUBJECT: ELECTION REPORT

On May 17th the City Clerk received the list of qualified voters and election day voter registers for the June 13, 2017 Special Election from the Division of Elections (DOE). A person is qualified to vote in a municipal election who, in accordance with Alaska Statutes and Homer City Code:

- a. Is a citizen of the United States;
- b. Has passed their eighteenth birthday or is such other age as prescribed by law for voting in State elections;
- c. Has been a resident of the municipality for 30 days immediately preceding the election;
- d. Is registered to vote in State elections at a residence address within the municipality at least 30 days before the municipal election at which the person seeks to vote.

Beginning May 26, 2017 the City Clerk's office staff began mailing ballots to qualified voters who requested ballots by mail, and 80 ballots were mailed. Beginning May 30th, the City Clerk's office staff began sending ballots to qualified voters who requested ballots by electronic transmission, and 52 ballots were either emailed or faxed.

The City Clerk's office staff verified each Absentee Ballot Application and documented the voter's precinct and voter number on the application prior to mailing, emailing, and faxing. Staff attempted to contact applicants who were not eligible so they would be aware they would not be receiving a ballot.

Beginning May 30, 2017 Absentee in Person voting began and was available to voters Monday through Friday from 8:00 am until 5:00 pm until Election Day. 743 people signed in on the Absentee in Person registers, four did not vote take a ballot and were crossed off the list, leaving 739 voters on the register, and 739 ballots were issued and returned, placed in the voter's Absentee in Person envelope, sealed and stored in the City's vault.

The City Clerk's office staff verified each ballot envelope using the list of qualified voters provided by DOE to confirm that each absentee in person voter is qualified to cast a vote in this election. The voter's number and precinct were written on the envelope of voters who are qualified and those who are not were documented as not on the voter list.

The same process was followed for 15 Special Needs ballots and 50 Questioned ballots.

Following the election, City Clerk's office staff compared each absentee ballot envelope with the precinct registers to ensure that no one who voted by the above mention means, had signed the register on Election Day.

On Election Day after the polls closed, the chair of Homer No. 2 precinct reported delivered their precinct materials and equipment reported a discrepancy between the total number of signatures in the precinct register and the number of ballots that went through the optical scan unit. In reviewing their reports, 488 voters signed the register and the optical scan unit recorded 477 ballots cast, an eleven ballot discrepancy. I reviewed their ballot accountability reports, question and special needs registers, and verified ballot stub numbers which are accurate. I then verified Homer No. 1 precinct and found they had 601 voters sign the register and 594 ballots cast, a seven ballot discrepancy. Both precincts reported consistent problems with the optical scan units not taking the ballots and having to make multiple attempts before the ballot would feed through. I contacted DOE and explained the issue and was advised that if needed, the election worker could push the yes button on the front of the machine and the voter could insert the ballot and it should go through. I passed that information on to the poll workers.

On June 15, 2017, I contacted Kenai Peninsula Borough Clerk Johni Blankenship for guidance on how to proceed as she is the Election Supervisor for all Borough precincts and I have not experienced a discrepancy like this. She and Deputy Borough Clerk Michele Turner were in Homer for the property tax appeal hearings and stopped by and we discussed process, equipment issues, and possible causes. The three of us counted the ballots that were turned in by Homer No. 2 and counted 488 ballots. The same number of voters who signed the register.

In hindsight I believe the advice I received from DOE was not correct for the situation that we were experiencing and that is what caused the discrepancies on election day.

RECOMMENDATION TO THE CANVASS BOARD:

Regarding election night discrepancies:

- Count and re-run both precincts ballots.

Regarding Absentee ballots:

- Count 717 Absentee in Person ballots that were verified as qualified voters in this election.
- 59 ballots were received by mail. Make a determination on two ballots and count all qualified ballots.
- 41 ballots were received by electronic transmission. Make a determination on two ballots and count all qualified ballots.
- Count 22 Questioned ballots that were verified as qualified voters in this election.
- Count 14 Special Needs ballots that were verified as qualified voters in this election.
